Ebrahim Mehtari is an Iranian post-election survivor of rape and torture.

Mahboubeh Abbasgholizadeh is a prominent human rights activist at the forefront of the Iranian women's movement since the 1990s. Abbasgholizadeh was detained for peacefully protesting against the unlawful prosecution of women's rights defenders and during the disputed Presidential elections of 2009.

Hadi Ghaemi is the Executive Director of the International Campaign for Human Rights in Iran. Since 2008, the International Campaign has served as a leading organization in documenting human rights violations in Iran and building international coalitions in defense of Iranian human rights defenders.

Omid Memarian is an Iranian journalist and human rights defender detained in 2004 for his work. Memarian received Human Rights Watch's highest honor in 2005, the 'Human Rights Defender Award'. He also received the Hellman/Hammett award that same year.

Diane Ala'i is the U.N. Representative of the Bahá'í International Community in Geneva, Switzerland.
